### Notes from the Arranger

In the fall of 2021, I was assisting the BYU School of Music with preparing musical selections for performance during the weekly devotional broadcast done at the Marriott Center on BYU Campus.

As part of this task, I was blessed to be able to work with Elder Neil L. Andersen, an apostle of Jesus Christ, and his wife, Kathy, in preparation for their devotional address on December 7. The Andersens desired three arrangements of Christmas songs that the congregation could sing along to but were “beefed up” by a choir, organ, and orchestra. This arrangement was one of the results, the first of the three sung as an opening hymn prior to the beginning of Elder Andersen’s address.

Writing this work was an intensely spiritual experience, and the writing reflects my joy in the joy sent to the world because of the birth of Jesus Christ.
